- Topic & Speaker # 1: Kia K – Project Plan for NA Events

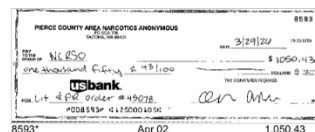
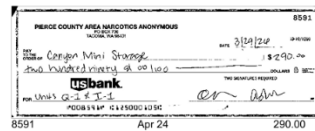
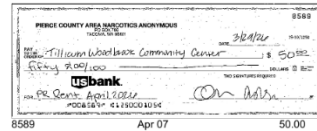
